## FIRST CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH OF ST. CLAIR—UNITED CHURCH OF CHRIST CONGREGATIONAL MEETING MINUTES SUNDAY, December 1, 2019

The meeting was called to order at 11:05 a.m. by Moderator, Lisa Hughes. A quorum was present. Lisa turned the meeting over to Ken Schultz, Treasurer, to discuss the Mission Budgets for 2019 and 2020; and the General Fund Annual Budget for 2020. Ken first discussed the Mission Budgets with a PowerPoint presentation:

Lisa Hughes pointed out that we have been very generous over the years to our local community and to state-wide support for UCC missions. Our church Mission Fund supported the following outreach projects without funding from B Morre Savings.

If all amounts are approved as noted above this will leave \$2,830 in BMoore Savings for the future. It also assumes we will not use these funds to balance the GF budget in 2019.

**Questions:** Why was KIDS not included in the 2019 and 2020 BMoore Mission Outreach? **Answer:** KIDS have had some major fundraising from the local community as well as support from the Community Foundation. Also, when contacted regarding their needs, KIDS replied that they needed help when changing over clothes for the different seasons.

**Suggestions**: to continue to be able to give back to the community through our outreach efforts.

- May have to take money from the General Fund to continue community outreach.
- Giving by members must increase to cover the outreach efforts.
- Congregation may want to revisit the Barbara Moore Fund Resolutions to continue the outreach from B Moore Savings.
- Increase memberships by inviting people to church.
- Don't place scholarships in the Mission Fund.
- New members are needed on Council to offer new ideas.

Veterans of the Cross One Great Hour of Sharing Neighbors in Need Holiday Food Baskets Strengthen the Church Food Pantry

Ken Schultz showed the full 2020 Mission budget. He stated that some of the BMoore Savings projects (Noted as **NEW**) were not included in prior years' Mission budgets, but will be accounted for in 2020 and future budgets. Therefore, Income and Expense totals are much higher than in 2019. Also, some IN/OUT lines such as Holiday Food baskets, Food pantry Drive, etc. are more predictable, therefore estimated amounts are now shown in the Income/Expense columns.

**Motion #3:** Doreen Vernier made a motion to Approve the 2020 Mission Budget; David Scheel seconded. MCU

**General Fund Budget for 2020**: (See attached at the end of this report)

Ken stated that the General Fund showed a major reversal in 2019 of Pledged Income vs. Non-Pledged Income. As a result, we were able to predict a much higher Pledge Income estimate of \$108,500. Consequently, we predict a lower Non-pledged income of \$15,000. The total expenses will be higher this year based on 2 primary factors: 1. A 2% increase in Salaries and FICA for all staff; 2. An adjustment in the Education Coordinator salary to account for full year of service instead of one semester. Once again, we show a budget deficit (-\$15,285). However, compared to last year (-\$17,100) it is less.

**Motion #4**: Brian Paret made a motion to Approve the 2020 General Fund Budget as presented; Bob Baden seconded. MCU

Ken thanked Amanda, Julie, and Caroline for the work they did in preparing the Budget presentations. He also thanked Council for their support.

Lisa Hughes thanked everyone on Council, Trustees, and the Congregation for their commitments to the church. She announced that she has served as Moderator for many years and is now stepping away from this position as the term limit is ending. She asked members to think about volunteering for Council positions where they would be able to voice their opinions and make changes they would like to see.

Meeting adjourned at 12 noon.
